Unvaccinated animals are a **RISK TO HUMAN HEALTH**

Owners of unvaccinated animals can be fined \$90+ per animal





If you suspect your pet has come into contact with a rabid animal, CALL YOUR LOCAL VETERINARIAN

Rabies vaccination is required by law in Ontario because it can be transmitted between humans and animals. Talk to your vet about how to protect your pet from rabies.
