



## Ontario implements mandatory masking policy

Today the provincial government announced that masks will be mandatory across the province as COVID-19 cases continue to rise in Ontario. Starting tomorrow (Oct. 3), masks must be worn in workspaces and indoor settings where physical distancing cannot be maintained.

While cloth masks may be worn, medical-grade masks are highly recommended for all clinic staff, especially when staff are working closely together for a prolonged period of time within the practice.
