

PROTECTING PETS FROM RABIES

PREVENTIVE MEASURES

including wildlife rabies control and routine vaccination of pets, have reduced rabies cases in domestic animals to an all-time low



After a pet's first vaccination, a booster shot is needed within **1 YEAR**



Then, vaccination is required every



Ontario dogs, cats and ferrets three months of age and over must have a current



or a **STATEMENT OF EXEMPTION** from a vet

Unvaccinated animals are a **RISK TO HUMAN HEALTH**

Owners of unvaccinated animals can be **fined \$90+ per animal**



If you suspect your pet has come into **contact with a rabid animal**, **CALL YOUR LOCAL VETERINARIAN**

Rabies vaccination is required by law in Ontario because it can be transmitted between humans and animals. Talk to your vet about how to protect your pet from rabies.
